Programmes > MBA Part time

Students pursuing part time MBA courses have a dual responsibility – towards their organization and themselves.

Organization: Application of the world changing lessons from the class rooms in day to day affairs of the organization to catapult it to eminence!

Individual: Absorb the business ideas from case studies to enrich one's own intellect and knowledge!

Duration and Time

The course will consist of 8 trimesters (two and a half years), each of 11 weeks duration. The classes will be held between 5.45pm and 9.15pm on all days from Monday to Saturday except holidays declared by the State Government.

The programme structure is given separately.

Eligibility

Candidates seeking admission to the MBA Evening Programme should satisfy the following qualifications and conditions:

- A pass in the degree level examination with 50% marks in aggregate from a university. For BA, BSc and B.Com students, a pass in the examination with 50% marks in Part III is the eligible qualification.
- Working as afull time employee of an organization.
- Applicants for the MBA programme must have a valid score in CMAT/CAT/KMAT.

Number of seats

Total number of seats for admission to the MBA Evening Programme is 30. Two seats are reserved for candidates deputed by Kerala government vide G.O. MS 194/85/H.Edn, dt. 24/8/1985. In the absence of such candidates, the seats will be filled from other applicants.

Reservation of seats

10% of the seats (3 seats) are reserved for scheduled caste/scheduled tribe candidates.

Admission procedure

Application form and prospectus can be obtained by sending a demand draft for Rs. 600 (by post) or a draft for Rs. 500 (in person) favouring CET School of Management payable at Thiruvananthapuram. Application form can also be downloaded from this website.

Candidates will be required to appear for an entrance test. Based on the score obtained in the entrance test, short-listed candidates will be called for interview and group discussion. Final selection will be based on the total admission scores obtained by candidates, computed by adding together the marks obtained in the entrance test, qualifying examination, group discussion & interview and for the work experience as per the prevailing norms and regulation in force.

Fee schedule

The tuition fee for the programme is Rs. 1.5 lakhs payable in the first six terms. Concession to SC/ST students is as per Government rules. Detailed fee structure of the programme is given below:

Tuition fees: Rs.25000 per trimester payable in the first six trimesters Rs. 1,50,000/-

Admission fees: Rs.1000, payable at the time of admission Rs. 1,000/-

Special fees: Rs. 4000 per year payable in the first two years

Rs. 8,000/PTA/Bus Fees: Rs. 6500, payable at the time of admission

Rs. 6,500/-

Caution Deposit: Refundable, but payable at the time of admission Rs 5,000/Total Rs. 1,70,500/-

Fees once paid will not be refunded.

Fees payable to the University: Payments to the University include Affiliation fee (Rs. 1000 payable at the time of admission), trimester examination fee (Rs. 500 per trimester), and Rs. 200 per theory paper. Fee for oral examination in the 7th and 8th trimesters will be in addition to these. All the payments to the University will be as decided by the University from time to time. While taking admission, the following payments are collected on behalf of the University:

Affiliation fee : Rs. 1000 1st trimester examination fee : Rs. 500 Fees for four courses in the first trimester : Rs. 800 Total payable at the time of admission : Rs. 2300

Fees payable to the University will be at rates fixed by the University from time to time.
