MBA Admission 2021-22 -Approval/Withholding of admission in respect of
College of Engineering Trivandrum - Order issued on 19.01.2022

ORDER

1. The College of Engineering Trivandrum, herein after referred as the MBA College has submitted the Prospectus and the same was provisionally approved by the Admission Supervisory Committee herein after referred as ASC, through communication 1st Paper referred above.

2. The ASC, through communication dated 10.11.2021 has directed the Principal of the MBA College to produce the list and supporting documents of the admitted candidates in respect of MBA Course for the academic year 2021-22.
3. Accordingly, the MBA College has submitted the list and supporting documents of admitted MBA Candidates for approval. The MBA College has also submitted the affiliation order received from the competent authorities for conducting the MBA Course for the academic year 2021-22. The ASC scrutinised the documents submitted by the MBA College and found that the College is having an intake strength of 120 seats for MBA full time Course and 30 seats for MBA part time Course in self financing stream for the academic year 2021-22.
4. In the present Pandemic Situation, the ASC has relaxed the admission procedure and issued certain directives for admission to MBA Course 2021-22, Wherein the MBA College shall give first preference to those candidates who have qualified in any of the Entrance Test such as KMAT, CMAT & CAT. If any vacancy arises after admitting the qualified candidates, the 2nd preference will be given to the candidates who have secured positive score in any of the above entrance tests. If vacant seats still remain vacant, the candidates shall be selected based on the qualifying degree examinations.
5. On verifying the records it is found that the MBA College has admitted 120 candidates in MBA Course for the academic year 2021-22. Among the 120 candidates admitted, 113 candidates have
